# NOTES TO REFS

Games that need refs are on the Alameda Flag Football calendar, separate from the player's calendar.

Times on the calendar are (theoretically) game start times. Please arrive ten minutes early to set up the field.

Please RSVP to calendar invites so I know you're gonna be there (or that you're not gonna be there). Thanks!

### Before the game

- Set up the 70x25 field from the rulebook. Mark the sideline with cones every five yards (not just no-run zones).
- Check each team's uniforms (basically make sure flag belts are on right).
- Give each head coach a chance to ask you questions.

## Start of game

- Announcer will announce each team and they run to midfield and line up.
- Give them a moment to shake hands with each other, say hi, etc.
- The team captain is whoever's on the end of the line closest to you.
- Coin toss (we usually do laces or spaces, but feel free to improvise).

## During the game

- I have stopwatches. One for the game clock and one for the play clock. Please try them out.
- Phones (or notepads) are fine for keeping score.
- Call the score and the time remaining at each change of possession.

## After the game

- If it's the last game, pick up pylons/cones and get them (plus ref gear) back into the gear box.
- After coach has had time to celebrate with the team, show the score to each head coach and get him/her to initial it or just say OK. If there's a dispute, note that.
